"1874 Marriage solemnized at Parish Church in the parish of Teynham in the County of Kent.

When married: October 17 1874

Name and Surname: George Baker, age 25, bachelor, labourer, Chilham (residence at time of marriage)

Father's name & surname: James Baker - labourer

Katherine Akhurst, age 20, spinster, Teynham (residence)

Father's name & surname: John Akhurst, labourer.

Married in the Parish Church according to Rites and Ceremonies after Banns by me Cecil Henry Fielding.

This marriage was solemnized between us George Baker and Katherine Akhurst in the presence of us, Mary Frances Monk, Alfred Morgan."

NB: Mary Frances Monk was the sister of C/Katherine Akhurst. Mary married John Monk in about 1872.

*Wendy's note: George's Primitive Methodist Hymn Book with his name and the date 1874 Chilham, (the year of his marriage) was found among his grandson Harry James Baker's effects. Held by Wendy Baker.
